Who should be followed by the CardioObstetrics Program*?

An OUTPATIENT CardioObstetrics referral is encouraged for women with any of these indications:

- Known pre-existing cardiac disease, considering pregnancy or already pregnant.
- Current or historical preeclampsia or gestational HTN at any gestational age, including postpartum.
- Current or historical spontaneous preterm birth ≤ 34 weeks.
- Current or historical growth restricted pregnancy requiring preterm delivery ≤ 37 weeks.
