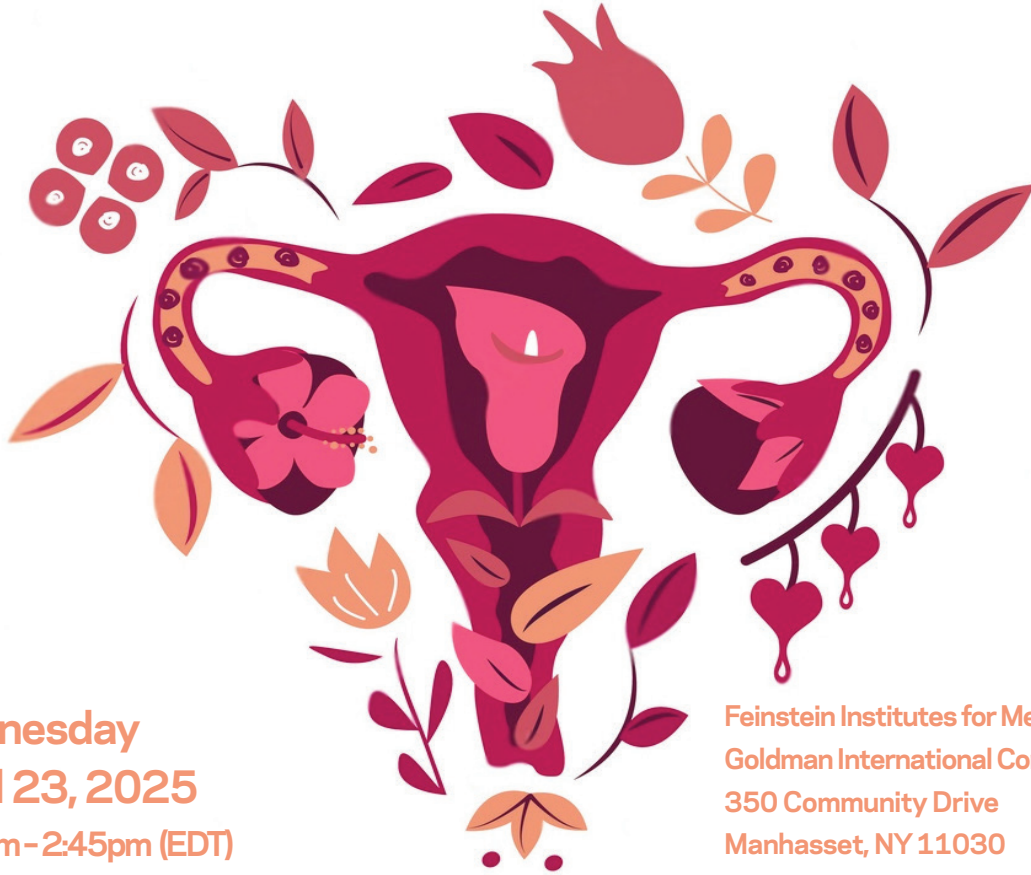

Statement of Need: Historically, EDs have not needed to provide comprehensive reproductive healthcare. But the landscape of the US healthcare system has shifted dramatically, as ED visits overall continue to rise. The scope of care traditionally offered in the ED must shift in response. An Update on Reproductive Health Practice in the ED will address the untapped potential for offering reproductive healthcare in the ED, including miscarriage management, contraception, and prenatal counseling. We will also address the role of reproductive health in SAFE/SANE care.

Program Objectives: All Northwell Health CME activities are intended to improve patient care, safety and outcomes. At the conclusion of this conference participants should be able to:

- **ASSESS** current reproductive healthcare protocols in the Emergency Department and develop a strategic plan to expand current protocols safely and methodically.
- **DEVELOP** a tailored miscarriage management protocol to their ED.
- **ANALYZE** weaknesses in referral practices for pregnant and parenting patients.
