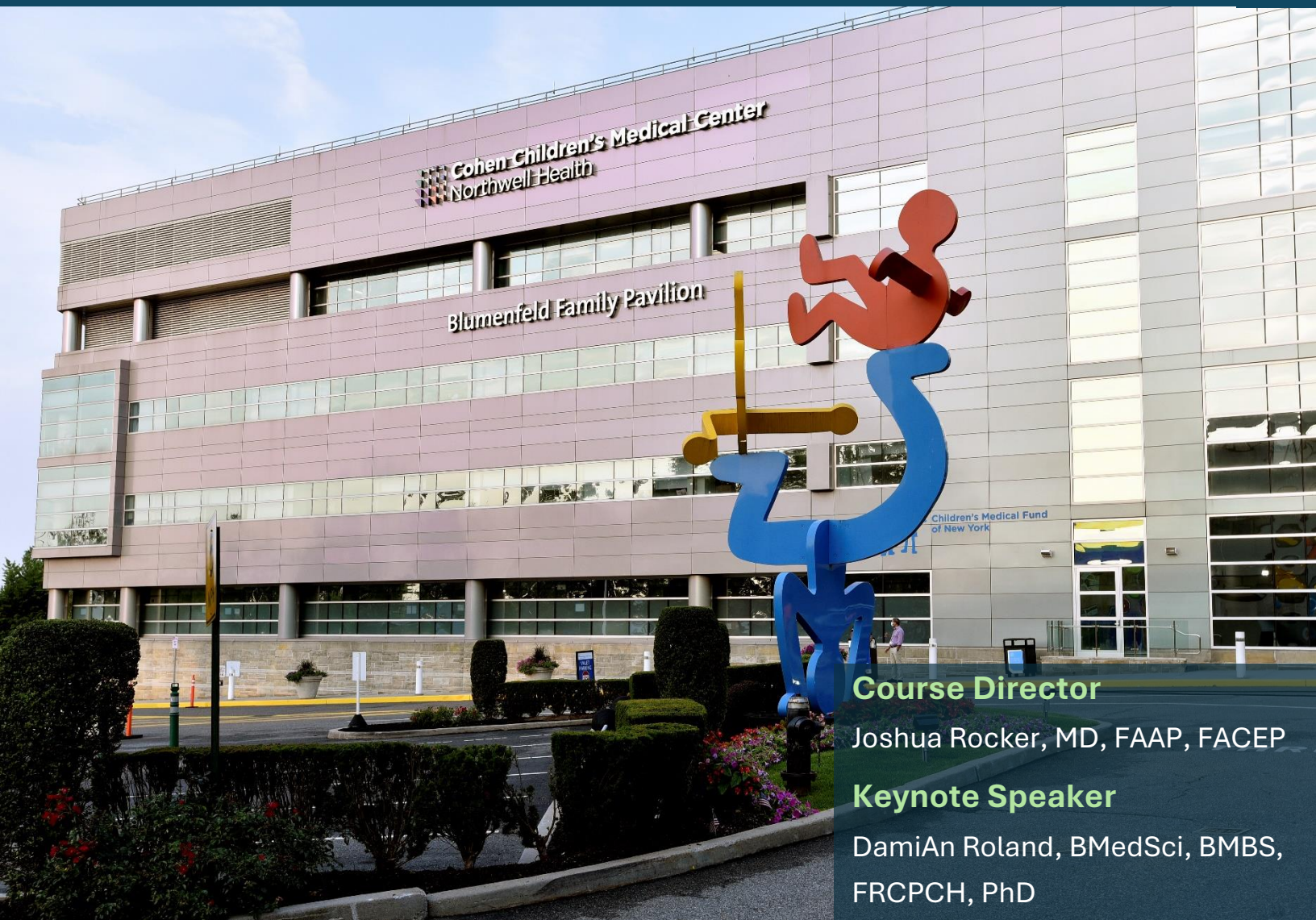

Statement of need: Pediatric Emergency Medicine is an extremely important and versatile field. Advancements in Pediatric Emergency Medicine are constantly happening, and the recommended guidelines are evolving. Members of the healthcare team must know and apply structured guidelines, and new advancements to optimize patient care. Although the new standards are in literature, they are not always necessarily applied due to barriers such as: Difficulty applying knowledge to real-world scenarios, Lack of exposure to specific cases, Resource constraints. The healthcare team needs a course teaching and exposing them to the application of recent and innovative tools and techniques for patient care. This course will cover the broad scope of addressing and applying best practices to optimize patient care per guidelines. The platform this year emphasizes the breadth of knowledge and skills required for our profession. This includes navigating pediatric surgery, radiology, OB/GYN, infectious disease, artificial intelligence in the pediatric emergency room, and evidence-based medicine. Professional practice gaps result from not all healthcare team members being constantly up to date on the most recently discovered evidence-based practices in PEM.

Program objectives: All Northwell Health CME activities are intended to improve patient care, safety and outcomes. At the conclusion of this conference, participants should be able to:

- **Identify** common pediatric surgical emergencies and determine the role of each of the emergency providers in initial management.
